

## Bear River RC&D



### Hazardous Fuels Reduction

Idaho Department of Lands provided a grant for \$12,600 to treat hazardous fuels along  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile of private land at the US Forest Service boundary in Cub River, Franklin County, Idaho. Local labor was utilized to remove Bigtooth Maple and other brushy species.

Next year another hazardous fuels removal project will concentrate on Translator Mountain, also in Franklin County. A grant from IDL has been secured for the Franklin County Commission to complete this work in partnership with the Bear River RC&D and was awarded in the amount of \$65,000.
