

Kiwanis Playground Project

The Panhandle RC&D in Nebraska facilitated working with the Scottsbluff Noon Kiwanis club in their efforts to build a 4 acre play ground for Scottsbluff, Terrytown and Gering, Nebraska communities.

- 650 volunteers donating over 5,000 hours.
- 15 volunteer contractors donated 1,000 hours of professional time.

The completed projected imagined in February of 2009 was constructed by August 20th of 2009.
