Skyline CWMA

The Castleland RC&D has been providing organizational support and serving as the fiscal agent for the Skyline Cooperative Weed Management Area (CWMA) since it was formed back in 2002. The Skyline CWMA is a collaborative effort of agencies and private landowners with the goal of controlling noxious weeds beyond jurisdictional boundaries. This year the Skyline CWMA completed 9 separate weed spraying projects in Carbon & Emery counties. The total acres treated during 2010 were over 2,000 acres. The CWMA also published another addition of



the "Weeds of Utah" calendar as an educational effort, and distributed over 4,500 of them to communities throughout Utah. In conjunction with the Skyline CWMA, Castleland RC&D had a booth at the Utah Weed Control Association's annual meeting to showcase its accomplishments and offer support to other CWMA's in the state.
