Stump Lake Park Campground Map

In June of 2009, the Red River RC&D Council was approached by the Nelson County Park Board to assist them in the development of a map of existing campsites located in Stump Lake Park. Stump Lake Park is a regional park that serves people from throughout the eastern part of North Dakota as well as people from out of state and Canada. The park offers many activities including softball, baseball, tennis, volleyball, miniature golf, roller-skating, hiking, camping, horseshoes, picnics, dancing, fishing, boating, and various other water sports.

The Nelson County Park Board requested technical assistance from the Red River RC&D Council to assist them in the development a map of the park so that they would have a base map of all the campsites and facilities located in the park. They will utilize the map as a hand out for campers upon their arrival into the park. The map was also enlarged and made into a sign as a guide for campers and their visitors at the entrance of the park. The Nelson County Park Board is also looking at uploading the map to the Stump Lake Park website as a reference for those looking at planning a trip to the park in the future.

In order to fulfill the request of technical assistance, the Red River RC&D Council acquired the services of the field office staff from the Nelson County NRCS office. The Nelson County NRCS staff, along with the Red River RC&D Council, conducted site visits to GPS campsites and gather the necessary information to compile the map. The RC&D Council met several times with the Nelson County Park Board to review drafts of the map and gather their input in the planning process.

The campground map was delivered to the Nelson County Park Board by the Red River RC&D Council in November of 2010. The Red River RC&D is glad to make things happen for the park and looks forward to assisting them with future projects.
